Conditions of Entry

1) Imagery criteria

- a. All photographs entered must be taken within Fiordland in order to be eligible for this competition.
- b. The images must be the original unpublished work of the entrant. Special exemption for "Then & Now" category entries, the NOW photo must be the original work of the exhibitor, however the THEN photograph may be from any source provided it is (a) properly attributed and (b) not subject to copyright (without the express permission for the print to be exhibited).
- c. A maximum of four entries per entrant applies. "Then & Now" entries (which requires two photographs count as ONE entry for the purposes of the competition maximum entry).
- d. Negatives or high resolution digital copies of all photographs entered must be supplied **at time of entry** otherwise they will not be accepted. (Clearly named on disc or marked on negative for easy identification.)

2) Display requirements

- a. A competition Entry Form must be attached to the back of each entry.
- b. All photographs must be mounted on matt board or card and ready to hang.
- c. Recommended minimum size specifications for all entries are 8" X 12" inches or 20cm X 30cm.
- d. Work may not be displayed if it does not meet a desired standard suitable for hanging and display.

3) Copyright Waiver

- a. By submitting work to this competition and exhibition the photographer/artist agrees to make the image available for the purpose of ongoing advertising, promotion, and other similar activities undertaken by Destination Fiordland (including the copying, reproduction, and publication of the work) and therefore waives all copyright to the image submitted.
- b. In the event that organisers wish to reproduce the image, all negatives and/or digital files of the image must be made available without charge.

4) Model Release Requirements

- a. All photographs that show people in a way in which they might be recognised should, where ever possible, be accompanied by a 'model release form' stating the person's permission to be included in the photograph and acknowledgment that there may be ongoing use of that image in the public domain. An example of a model release form is available from Destination Fiordland on request. Failure to complete this form will be at the liability of the entrant.

5) Entry Delivery & Pick Up

- a. Entries will close at **5pm Friday 21st of August 2009**. All works must be at the designated collection point by this date. NO late entries will be accepted.
- b. All entrants are responsible for delivery and pick up of work from the designated collection point, that being the Te Anau Public Library.
- c. All freight costs to and from the designated collection point are to be met by the entrant who submitted the work for competition & exhibition.

6) Judging & Prize Allocation ** Prizes maybe cash OR Voucher*

- a. Winning entries for the 6 main categories will be selected by a judging panel which will include representatives from Destination Fiordland and sponsor's, as well as a professional photographer/guest judge.
- b. Other prizes will be awarded solely by the sponsor of that prize, entirely at this prize sponsor's discretion.
- c. The judges' decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- d. Winners for all categories with exception of the 'Peoples Choice' award will be presented their prizes at the opening ceremony of the Destination Fiordland Photographic Competition Exhibition.
- e. The Peoples Choice Award will be awarded at the conclusion of the Exhibition event.

7) Exhibition Display

- a. The arrangement of the exhibition display is to be undertaken by the organisers of the event. Design and final exhibition details are at the discretion of the event organisers.
- b. Entries to all categories must conform to minimum display standards (as outlined further in Conditions of Entry - Display Requirements) and be ready for display/exhibition.
- c. The organisers reserve the right to refuse to display work that is not adequately presented. This will be at the organiser's discretion.

8) Storage

- a. Entry to the competition means that the original work submitted may be held by organisers for display for a period of up to three months or such longer period determined by the organisers (to allow for touring of exhibition finalists).
- b. Destination Fiordland or Fiordland Promotions Association will not take responsibility for any damage to works delivered to collection point, or any damage incurred by works in transit to the exhibition venue or collection point.

9) General Conditions

- a. Although the utmost care will be taken by organisers, they do not accept responsibility for loss of or damage done to exhibits during transit, while on show at exhibition venues, or while in storage.
- b. Entry to the competition indicates acceptance of the conditions as stated herein.
