How to get there:

From Te Anau: head towards Mossburn. After around 5 minutes turn left down Kakapo Road and follow signs to Takaro Lodge. Once you enter the big gate please follow signs to the picnic. Allow 40 minutes drive from Te Anau, mostly along gravel.

From Invercargill/Queenstown: head towards Te Anau. Around 20 minutes after Mossburn watch out for a large house name on the right called Josswood. Take the next turning on the right into Kakapo Road and follow signs to Takaro Lodge. Once you enter the big gate please follow signs to the picnic. Allow 2.25 hours drive from Invercargill and 2.5 hours from Queenstown. The last 30 minutes is along gravel.
